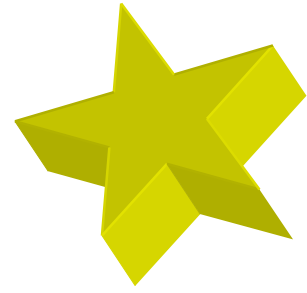




Be a Reading STAR!



Be a Reading Star is a new reading enrichment program at the All Saints Library. It is a completely optional program, designed to encourage reading. Children in all grades can participate and help us grow our constellation of reading “STARS” throughout the library. It’s a simple process. Here’s how it works.

Each month students will bring home a reading log to complete. At the end of the month, they will return it with their parents’ signature. All students who return their log will be able to write their name on a “star” which will hang in our library. Also, they will be entered in our monthly raffle. One student per grade level will win a raffle prize each month.

Parents, please encourage your child to participate and read at home each night. Remember, reading together each night and modeling reading is a wonderful way to encourage and build literacy in all children.

The Read-To Me Club:

For pre-readers and beginning readers in Grades K and 1

Students must read 10 books per month, read on their own, or read to them by a parent.

The Reading on My Own Club:

For students in Grades 2 and 3

Students in these grades must read at least 3 books per month. They will get an additional raffle ticket for every 2 books read. (Age appropriate please.)

Star Readers Club:

For students in Grades 4 and up:

Students in these grades must read at least 2 books per month. They will get an additional raffle ticket for every 2 books read. (Age appropriate please.)
